
1/5 PT-17 SUPPLEMENTAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Installation of optional cockpit dashboards:

As pictured on page 11 of the instruction manual, the dashboard with the radio switch and voltage meter goes in the rear cockpit and the dashboard with the red lever goes in the front cockpit. Set the dashboards at a comfortable viewing angle and secure each dashboard at the front of its cockpit with 5-minute epoxy.

CONNECTIONS —

- **A.** To your **RECEIVER**: use the longest lead with a servo-like connector.
- B. To your radio's 4 or 5 cell NiCd or NiMH BATTERY: Connect the lead pictured at the center-right.
- C. To recharge your radio's 4 or 5 cell NiCd or NiMH battery, connect your CHARGER to the shortest lead with a servo-like connector.



2. Installation of an optional upgraded dummy engine:

You could glue the Dummy Engine onto the nose surface or add a few wood screws to mount, make sure it attached to the nose solidly to prevent it fall off in the air.

Wood Dummy Engine is only recommended for electric setup. If you want to set up for glow or gas power, a radial engine will be the best choice and you do not need our dummy engine.
